Hotel information:

We have rooms being held at the Nighthotel Broadway (<https://www.nighthotelbroadway.com>) at 215 West 94th Street, New York, NY 10025. The first sixteen rooms we book are \$205 a night. After that we have an additional eight rooms reserved at \$250 a night. (There are also taxes and a facilities fee.)

To reserve a room: Please email info@nighthotels.com with your name, address, phone number, and credit card information, and write that you are in the "Council of Centers" group and "2610 Council" room block. (Do not register through the hotel website.) Please add to your email: "I'm interested in either a bronze queen- or king-sized room." There is no difference in price if you get the king-sized room; it just depends on what is available. If you do not want to send your credit card information in the email please include a note asking the Reservations staff for a call back so you can provide it that way.

Rooms at this rate will be held until Sept. 30. The cancellation date without penalty is Oct. 15.
